Wine: 2013 Domaine du Tariquet Cotes de Gascogne Rose

Price: \$11.99

Availability: Giant Eagle Market District in Dublin, the Hills Market, Lucky's Market, Palmer's Beverage, Tutto Vino and Weiland's Market; and the wine lists at Veritas Tavern and Vito's Wine Bar

Aroma: strawberry, guava and roses with a grapy base

Flavor: The striking saffronlike color is neither dark nor light; guava hints precede a satisfying crispness and medium-short finish.

Notes: A dry rose from southwestern France that is made from both southern (syrah, tannat) and northern (cabernet franc, merlot) grapes, the wine achieves its subtle complexities with only 12 percent alcohol. Serve no more than lightly chilled with all manner of summer fare, including spicy dishes.
