POINTING UP the interest in rosé wines, a new one from Domaine du Tariquet was launched at the London Wine Fair.

This is the Marsalan Rosé, produced in limited quantities. The Marsalan is a little known and rarely grown grape, developed in 1961 from the union of Cabernet Sauvignon and Grenache Noir.

After a series of trials, Domaine du Tariquet were impressed enough to produce this wine after the 2009 harvest. About £7.99 a bottle. A good Summer option.
